Language Requirement: For the programmes taught in English, we strongly recommend that non-native English speakers or students not taking their home university degree in English provide a *TOEFL* score of 550 or <u>equivalent</u> or have an English professor complete the <u>English language certificate</u>, attesting to a minimum of B2 according to the Common European Framework.
