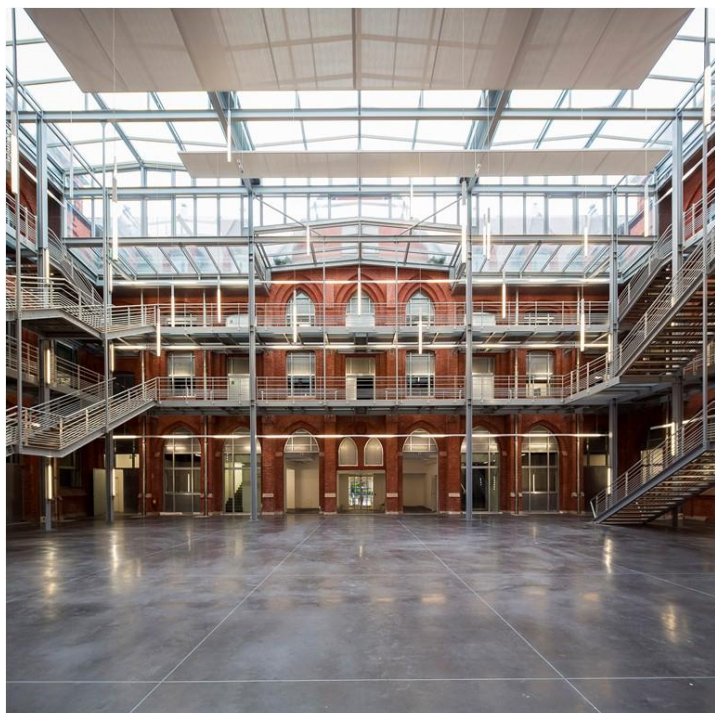

### Vauban Campus (Bachelor)

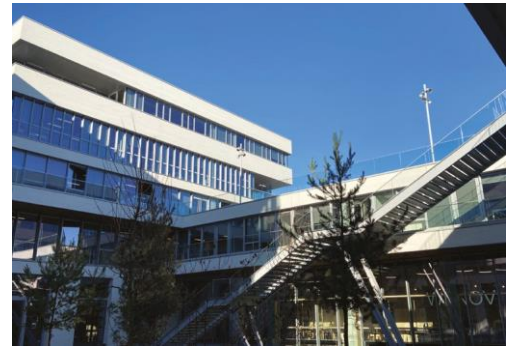
Boulevard Vauban, Lille
