ONLINE VERSIONS OF FINAL THESES

1. Choose the English version of the e-catalogue.
2. Choose **Catalog**.
3. Choose **Advanced search**.
- Type *theses (bachelor)* or *theses (master)* or *theses (doctorate)* in the field **Keyword**. To find theses on specific topic add the subject word in the same field – e.g. *theses (master) marketing*.
- Choose **Language** – e.g. *English*
- Choose **Type** – *Online publication*
- Click on **Search**.
4. Click on the **Read more!** link to open the entry of the thesis.
5. The link to the full text of the thesis is located on the last row of the entry - **Electronic location**. Click on the link to open the full text of the thesis.

PRINTED VERSIONS OF FINAL THESES

The theses can be ordered from the archive in the library. The final theses can be read only on the spot in the reading room.

1. Choose the English version of the e-catalogue.
2. Choose **Catalog**.
3. Choose **Advanced search**.
- Type *theses (bachelor)* or *theses (master)* or *theses (doctorate)* in the field **Keyword**. To find theses on specific topic add the subject word in the same field – e.g. *theses (master) marketing*.
- Select **Language** – e.g. *English*
- Select **Type** – *Manuscript*
- Choose the EBS Library collection from the **Libraries** drop down menu – type the word *EBS* and choose *EBS Raamatukogu*
- Click on **Search**.
4. Click on the **Read more!** link to open the entry of the thesis.
5. Click on the tab **Occurring** in the end of the entry.
6. Click on **EBS Raamatukogu**.

7. If the thesis is marked **confidential** on the row **Note**, you will need a written permission from the author to read it.

Example**Advanced search**

Type the phrase *bachelor's theses* in the field **Keyword**. Select **Language – English**.

Select **Type – Manuscript**. Choose **EBS Raamatukogu** from the drop down menu **Libraries**.

Click on **Search**.
